# **GENERAL INFORMATION**

The main entrance of the Istituto Superiore di Sanità (ISS) is located in Viale Regina Elena, 299, Rome, in front of the "Città Universitaria".

## How to get to the Institute:

### Leonardo da Vinci airport

Taxi (cost about €40,00)

Non-stop train to Termini Station (a on map below, cost €11) – Time 30 minutes

Then take bus: (ticket 1,00 €uro)

492 (get off at Piazzale del Verano, b on map below)

310 (get off at Viale dell'Università, c on map below)


Underground (ticket 1,00 €uro)

B line (Blue Line) (get off at "Policlinico") and walk for 10 minutes or take tram/bus N° 19 or 3 (get off at 3<sup>rd</sup> stop right opposite the Institute main entrance)

Train for Orte/Fara Sabina (stop Tiburtina Station, d on map below, cost €5.50) – Time 45 minutes; then take either Bus N° 71, 492, or 163, (3<sup>rd</sup> stop Tiburtina/Castro Laurenziano, (e) on map below) (ticket 1,00€uro).

#### Ciampino Airport

Taxi (cost about €40,00) Shuttle to Termini Station (€10) then follow instructions above



#### Other useful information

## It's highly recommended to go to the taxi ranks to take the taxis

Transport tickets cost 1 Euro each and last for 75 minutes. You can use the same ticket for the metro and bus provided the trip lasts no more than 75 minutes. However, you are entitled only to one trip on the metro (i.e. you can't take the metro, then a bus, then the metro again even if you are within the 75 minutes). Please remember to stamp the ticket after boarding buses

# **BTI - Biglietto Turistico Integrato (Integrated Tourist ticket)**

This is a 3 day travel pass for the all the metro and bus network. It costs 11€ Tickets may be purchased at tobacconists and newspaper kiosks anywhere
